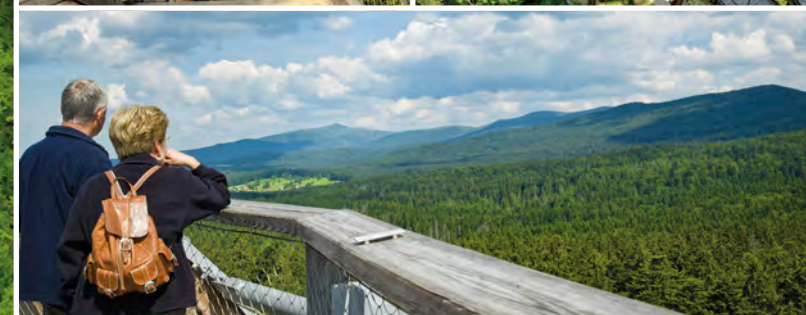

Discover and Experience the Treetop Walk

With a total length of 1,300 meters (including the ramp in the tower) and a height of 8–25 meters, the treetop walk winds its way through the beeches, firs and spruces of the mixed mountain forest, with numerous learning and activity stations along the way.

Forest Island Platform

The Forest Island is a 270 sq. m. platform which offers 3 instruction stations on the topic of the water cycle. A rest area featuring a spectacular grid recliner 20 meters off the ground invites you to kick back and relax.

View Tower

The highlight of the treetop walk is the tree tower. Once you reach the 44 meter high platform, you are rewarded with a splendid view: the sea of the Bavarian and Bohemian forests spreads out past Lusen and Rachel over hundreds of kilometers. On clear days, the view even reaches as far as the northern flank of the Alps, stretching across the horizon from East to West.

Family Friendly

Our treetop walk is a great place to spend the day with all the family – thanks to our learning and activity stations and our family tickets.

Wheelchair Friendly

The treetop walk and the view tower (lower platform 40 m above ground) have a maximum gradient of 6 %, making them easy to use with wheelchairs and prams alike. The wire fencing of the railing grants a free view of the surroundings even from a seated position. The Hans-Eisenmann-Haus, the animal reserve and the various restaurants are also wheelchair accessible.

By advance notification, wheelchairs, wheeled walkers, buggies and handcarts can be borrowed free of charge.

Nationalparkzentrum Lusen

Experience the fascinating woodland wilderness of the Bavarian Forest National Park in the modern Hans-Eisenmann-Haus visitor centre, the animals in their natural environment in the animal reservation, the forest flora and rocks – right by the treetop walk. www.nationalpark-bayerischer-wald.bayern.de/english

Arrival & Parking

Pay parking is available right at the treetop walk. Please pay attention to the indications on the signage. On high-volume days, the parking area may be full. For this reason, we recommend using public transport if possible. Coming from all directions, the Igelbus (hedgehog bus) is the most convenient, economic and environmentally friendly option to reach the treetop walk. Present your Igelbus ticket at the ticket office and get 1.00 € off your entrance fee.
