The „Igelbus“ is an environmentally friendly and inexpensive way to reach the Treetop Walk and we also offer a discount if you show us your bus ticket at the entrance. www.bayerwald-ticket.com

Our Treetop Walk is a great place to spend the day with the whole family – thanks to our learning and activity stations and our family tickets.

Important notes for visitors

The Treetop Walk experience is possible in all seasons. Due to weather conditions, e. g. thunderstorms, storms or hail, we have to close the trail at short notice for safety reasons.

-  Dogs and pets are not allowed on the path, except for registered assistance dogs.
-  Bicycles, scooters and similar vehicles are also not allowed on the trail for safety reasons.
-  Wheelchairs or walkers are available for loan at the ticket office.

Wildlife area and visitor centre

Discover the woodland wilderness of the Bavarian Forest National Park at the Lusen National Park Centre, which our Treetop Walk is located in. The wildlife area right next to the path lets visitors experience the forest inhabitants in their natural environment.
